CRITERIA FOR ALL AWARDS

1. Most awards, except for the Awards of Exceptional Contribution, will be awarded annually if satisfactory nominations are received, in compliance with the Awards Terms of Reference at the discretion of the BCCFP Awards Committee
2. A nominator is required for each award
3. Each nomination must be accompanied by a cover letter from the Nominator addressing the specific reasons why the Nominator believe the Nominee warrants the proposed recognition
4. In the submission, the Nominator will:
 - a. ensure/confirm that the Nominee meets the required criteria for the award proposed, and
 - b. address other elements noted below, which would indicate why their proposed Nominee warrants the award amongst other candidates

BC Community Family Physician

- CFPC member in good standing
- “Community” family physicians are defined as:
 - working in a more traditional family practice (not primarily a university or teaching facility)
 - maintaining a breadth of practice
 - providing ongoing longitudinal care
- Outstanding commitment and contribution to the goals of Family Medicine
- May be described as having qualities including:
 - excellence and/or uniqueness of practice
 - innovation in developing a new program(s) to address health care needs in the community
 - charity and humanitarian work

(Please note the BC Community Family Physician award is not the same as the Canadian Family Physician of the Year award. Contact the BCCFP for a separate nomination form for the Canadian Family Physician of the Year award.)

BC Rural Family Physician

- CFPC member in good standing
- “Rural” is defined as practicing in an area covered by the Rural Subsidiary Agreement (Appendix A) – for a copy of the listed communities contact the BCCFP
- Maintaining a breadth of traditional practice
- Providing exceptional longitudinal care
- Longstanding contribution to a rural community
- May be described as having qualities including:
 - excellence and/or uniqueness of practice
 - innovation in developing a new program(s) to address health care needs in the community
 - charity and humanitarian work

BC Family Practice Teacher

- CFPC member in good standing
- Either an undergraduate and/or a postgraduate clinical teacher and/or preceptor
- Providing outstanding teaching in Family Medicine
- Nominators will usually be students or residents for whom the Nominee has been a teacher and/or preceptor

BC Family Practice Researcher

- CFPC member in good standing
- Candidates will be recommended on the basis of:
 - innovative program of research
 - published article(s) in peer-reviewed journals
 - substantial leadership to others in developing research projects of acknowledged quality

Exceptional Contribution to Family Medicine

- May be a CFPC member or a non-member
- Not limited to medical doctors
- Up to three awards may be awarded annually at the discretion of the BCCFP
- Specific noteworthy contribution and/or achievement to the health of a community or the discipline of Family Medicine
